



PREMIUM BASEBALL POLICIES AND SERVICES

In order to preserve the standards and traditions of Clemson Baseball, IPTAY, The Clemson Athletic Department, Coaches and Student-Athletes would like for you to adhere to a few policies that will ensure a safe and competitive environment.

Services:

- Premium seat patrons will enjoy in-seat wait service for all regularly scheduled games. VIP Waitstaff will be available to you for your food and beverage purchases. Please note, to keep from disrupting the game, this service will be limited to breaks in the game such as between innings and half inning changes.
- Rhino Security Services will be in the area checking tickets and ushering patrons to their seats.
- Single game Premium Field Level tickets may be available this season. Only current premium seat holders may purchase additional seats if available. Please contact IPTAY Hospitality for additional tickets.

Premium Seating **Opens:** One and a half (1.5) hours prior to first pitch.

Premium Seating **Closes:** 30 minutes after the game conclusion.

PREMIUM BASEBALL POLICIES AND SERVICES

Policies:

- Every person sitting in the premium section must have the appropriate ticket.
- Please make every attempt to attend or to have your seats occupied by a Tiger for every home game. **When bringing guests to the premium level seats, we ask that your guests show support for Clemson Baseball and be respectful of our student-athletes by not wearing the colors or gear of our opponents.**
- You may return any unused tickets to an IPTAY staff member prior to the game so we can ensure all seats are filled for every home game.
- Premium ticket holders should not engage in threatening physical actions, disorderly behavior, or disruptive conduct.
- Premium ticket holders will be respectful and should not interact with umpires, game officials, players and coaches.

Clear Bag Policy:

Clemson University, working with law enforcement officials, has implemented a Clear Bag Policy at Doug Kingsmore Stadium since the 2017 baseball season. While we encourage fans to not bring any type of bags, outlined below is what will be permissible to carry into the stadium should a bag be necessary:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12." (Official Clemson Tigers logo clear plastic tote bags are available at local retail stores), or
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar).
- Small clutch bags, approximately the size of a hand (no larger than 4.5" x 6.5"), with or without a handle or strap can be taken into the stadium.
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.





PREMIUM BASEBALL 2025 INFORMATION

Other:

- ADA seats are available on a first come, first served basis behind home plate and along the baselines. Please see a member of the IPTAY Hospitality or Clemson Athletics staff to access these seating areas.
- A first aid station is located behind the home plate in the guests services booth near the main gate.
- In the case of an emergency (Police, Fire or Medical), dial 911. State the emergency, your name, location where the assistance is needed, and remain on the line. All other problems should be reported to an IPTAY Hospitality or Clemson Athletics representative.
