PLAYER DEVELOPMENT & FACILITIES UPDATES

The Clemson University Rowing program has a proud tradition of success that includes four CRCA All-Americans, an ACC title and the highest point total in ACC Regatta History (63 points) in the past decade. As we continue the expansive growth of collegiate athletic success, it is important the Clemson Rowing continues to train and compete at an elite level.

Rowing has been an investment over the past decade for colleges across the nation. Institutions have invested in player and team equipment to ensure the safety and health of student-athletes while also considering cost saving measures over time. Four primary investments include a launch motorboat, nutritional and medical staff, facility upgrades and a west coast trip.
